### Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2018 between

**Department of Women and Child Development, Government of Maharashtra** having its office address at 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, New Administrative Building, Opposite Mantralaya, Mumbai (hereinafter referred to as "DWCD"), and

**Integrated Child Development Service Commissionerate** having its office address at 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Raigad Bhavan, C.B.D. Belapur, Navi Mumbai, - 400614 (hereinafter referred to as "ICDS"), and

**Wasan Knowledge Hub** having its office address at Hyatt Regency, Basement, IA Project Rd, Ashok Nagar, Andheri East, Mumbai - 400099, Maharashtra (hereinafter

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referred to as "WASAN") And henceforth collectively both are referred to as "parties" to this MoU.

WHEREAS, DWCD is the nodal department of Government which governs the implementation of schemes for welfare of women and children with specific focus on their holistic growth, development and protection.

WHEREAS, ICDS is responsible for implementation of Integrated Child Development Scheme in the State of Maharashtra to address the growth needs of children under the age of six years, Pregnant and Lactating Women and Adolescent Girls in a holistic manner.

WHEREAS, WASAN is a center for knowledge and skill development, offering global standards of learning practices. WASAN specializes in skill development, behavioral development, organizational development, Life Skills Development and various other industry specific programmes.

**This MoU is being entered into for collaboration under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) to provide skill development to under privileged women & girls in 100 Anganwadi Centres in Mumbai so they can access opportunities of higher earning through skill development.**

WHEREAS parties in principle agree to cooperate, to have further dialogues and to further negotiate and finalize the mutual beneficial relations.

#### **1. Scope of Work:**

In consideration of the premises the parties hereby agree as follows:

##### **i. Activities to be carried out by WASAN:**

- Carry out screening of potential beneficiaries in the Anganwadis identified in discussion with DWCD & ICDS.
- Prepare detailed plan of conducting training sessions including trainers, hours of training and topics covered.
- Conducting the Skill Development Training program for identified beneficiaries (women and girls) along with Certification in - 1) Housekeeping and 2) Store Keeping to enhance their employability & earnings
- Conduct the training programs leveraging its industry leading content and delivery methodology
- Support the trained candidates in developing a self sustainable model for higher income generation in active participation of the community.
- WASAN through its partners will support the trained candidates in identifying the employment opportunities. However, at no point of time does WASAN guarantees employment (Temporary or Permanent) to the trained candidates

##### **ii. Activities to be carried out by DWCD & ICDS:**

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- Support WASAN and its partners in identification and mobilization of candidates to undertake Skilling/ Training
- DWCD & ICDS shall not provide any financial support, but the frontline staff under DWCD & ICDS shall support in implementation of the project

## 2. General Provisions:

- i. It is hereby expressly made clear that the intention of the parties is not to create binding agreement between the parties and no party shall have right to file claim against other party.
- ii. The parties understand that neither this MoU gives any right to any party, nor does it creates a partnership, joint collaboration or employment is created as a result of this MoU. This MoU is not intended to create legally binding obligations on either Party.
- iii. Except as expressly provided by this MoU, no Party will be liable for or bound by any representations, acts or omissions whatsoever of the other party.
- iv. Each Party will bear all of its own expenses necessary to meet its duties and obligations under this MoU. Neither party can create or cause to create any charge against the other party as per this MoU.
- v. All the Terms & conditioned mentioned in the Department GR No: ABV-2015/ CR No.31/ Desk-5 dated 20<sup>th</sup> May 2015 regarding Implementation of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiatives for Women and Child Development Department, Government of Maharashtra has to be binding on the Agency

## 3. Validity of the MoU Agreement:

This MOU will come into effect on date of signature by all partners and will end after 6 Months from the date of signing of this agreement. This period of 6 months include programme implementation (3 Months) followed by Monitoring (3 Months).

## 4. Amendment:

This MOU may be varied at any time by mutual agreement of the parties in writing. It shall be reviewed one month before the end of contract date or at a time mutually agreed by the parties for possible renewal.


## 5. Termination:


